Visa Application Process

Please note that there are specific requirements when applying for a visa from the Dublin office.

Applications should be made online to the Ghana High Commission www.ghanahighcommissionuk.com

Select **Ireland** as the Country of Residence

Select **Dublin** as the Processing Office

Select Postal Service

Please note the Dublin Consulate no longer offers counter service. All applications must be submitted by Registered Post and include an €8 stamp for return Registered Postage. Postal Orders should be payable to Ghana Consulate Dublin and enclose the relevant documents listed below. Postal applications are dispatched every Thursday. Please allow two weeks processing time.

One copy of the completed online form should be printed and signed (prints out as one page)

For all applications:

- **Please include the current passport** which must be valid for at least 6 months to expiration
- One copy of the completed and signed application form
- One passport size photograph
- Tourist visas (B2) do not require a letter of invitation
- If you require a business visa (B1) please include a letter from the sending and receiving organisation to support your application
- If you require a voluntary worker visa (J1) please include a letter from the voluntary organisation
- Minors and children under the age of 18 travelling to Ghana need written parental authorisation including copies of parents' passports
- In accordance with international health regulations, all persons entering Ghana are required to have a valid certificate of Immunisation against Yellow Fever. It is not necessary to send it for your visa.
- The relevant fee:
 - Single transit €55
 - Multiple transit €75
 - Single entry (3 month) €80
 - Multiple entry (6 month) €130
 - Multiple entry (1 year) €195
 - Multiple entry (2 year) €260

Please note that Application Process will only commence on receipt of the hard copy of your application form with all required supporting documents at the Consulate.

Visas commence on the date that they are issued and are only valid for the time specified on the visa, therefore applicants must calculate the dates of their trip and not apply too early/late.
